INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Supply of Fishmeal Plant

MATSYAFED is a cooperative federation for the development of fisheries in the state of Kerala.

MATSYAFED is planning to establish a wet fish meal plant in Alleppy District of the State of Kerala in India for which the plant is to be procured through open competitive selection process.

The plant is meant to produce best quality fish meal using fresh fish sourced directly from the local fishermen.

The plant is to be operated with a firewood based boiler with sufficient capacity of steam generation.

The objectives of the plant

- 1. As part of Tsunami Rehabilitation program, Government of India has allocate special package to Arattupuzha Panchayat of Alleppey District.**
- 2. The package includes a project to set up a fish meal plant.**
- 3. Matsyafed is selected as the Agency to implement this Project.**
- 4. Kerala is state with a fish landing of more than 7 lakhs tons and about 40% of the total landing is oil sardine. Matsyafed would like to tap this resource and to produce best quality fish meal mostly by utilizing this resource. The plant may also utilize other fishery resources for the production of the fish meal.**

Specifications of the plant and supply requirements

The plant has to have the following part of machinery for processing 80 tons of wet and oil fish.

1. Boiler
2. Steam cooker
3. Screw press
4. Rotating disc drier
5. Decanter
6. Centrifuge
7. Sieve screening
8. Grinding machine
9. Meal cooler
10. scaling and packing systems
11. Conveyor system required for the plant
12. Deodorizing system
13. Tanks required for the heating, storing water and oil
14. Electrical control system
15. Accessories and spares

The plant has to handle the material for whole process on a conveyor system and have to process the stick water arising of the system to get maximum yield from the raw material. The system must be synchronized and should have capacity to produce the highest percentage of protein in the fish meal produced.

The plant must have system for separation of fish oil to best quality and production of good quality fish meal.

The supplier of the fish meal plant should supply the machinery, erect and commission the plant to the satisfaction of the Matsyafed.

The machinery shall have a warranty of one year and the supplier should have a system in place for after sale services of the plant.

Eligibility criteria

The applicant /Agency shall have a minimum of three years experience in the supply of fishmeal plant, allied equipments and accessories.

The applicant have shall successfully completed the supply of similar plants in the last one year.

Such plants shall have been erected, commissioned and is commercially being operated as of now.

Applicant/ agency shall have the registered office / authorized Agency/coordinating office in India.

The Applicant/Agency shall have National/ International reputation.

The Applicant/ Agency shall have to warranty the plant and machinery at least for one year.

The Applicant/ Agency shall have a system in place for after sale services of the plant.

MATSYAFED invites Preliminary Expression of Interest from reputed suppliers of fish meal plant “ for supply ,erection and commissioning of a wet and oily fishmeal plat of capacity of 80 tons per day with single line system to be erected and commissioned in Arattupuzha Panchayat of Alleppy District of the State of Kerala , India.

Interested applicants shall send their expression of interest to Managing Director, Matsyafed, Kamaleswaram, Mancuad P.O. Trivandrum, Kerala State, India on or before 30 11.2009.

Once the preliminary expression of interest is received companies will be short listed on the basis of their experience and capacity for submission of Proposals. The Managing director reserve the right to accept or reject any or all expression of interest without assigning any reason there of.

Annual reports for the last three years

Details of supplies of specified/ similar plant/plants made during the last one year.

Evaluation criteria

Each applicant on request shall make presentations before the Managing director and his team to establish their eligibility.

Short listing of interested parties shall be based on meeting eligibility criteria on receipt of EOI, Presentations, and evaluations thereof.

Submission of EOI

All costs and expenses associated with submission of EOI shall be borne by the applicants themselves and MATSYAFED shall have no liability in any manner in this regard. MATSYAFED reserves the right without assigning any reason whatsoever to terminate the process of supply.
